The Bogey Grille Character Scholarship is being offered each year by Bogey Grille of Ponte Vedra Beach and is presented by Derek Prince. This scholarship is open to all seniors of Ponte Vedra High School. The scholarship is a non-recurring single scholarship in the amount of \$1000. The focus of the selection committee will be on students whom have demonstrated exemplary character in and out of school. Scholarship winners will be selected based on demonstrated hard work, service to the community, and good character. The application deadline is April 28, 2017 for consideration.

Minimum Qualifications for applicants:

- 1. Be a U.S. citizen and permanent resident of St. Johns County, Florida for at least one year. Proof of permanent residence may include a driver's license, voter's registration or passport.
- 2. Be a full-time, on-campus student (not exclusively on-line) at Ponte Vedra High School.
- 3. Provide an official transcript of all secondary academic work demonstrating a minimum 2.5 grade point average. If a student attended more than one school, a transcript from Ponte Vedra High School showing grades for coursework transferred in will be sufficient.
- 4. Complete the application by the advertised deadline and write a short personal essay stating why you should be awarded this scholarship with a focus on why developing exceptional character means to you and steps you have taken to demonstrate excellent work ethic, service to your school or community, and are of good character.
- 5. Provide three professional letters of reference from teachers, coaches, school administrators, employers, or professional mentors. These letters must be submitted with your application in an envelope signed and sealed by your reference.

Applicants who fail to provide letters of reference, transcripts, essay, signature, or completed application will be considered incomplete and will not advance in the selection process.

Scholarship funds may only be used for qualified educational expenses, including tuition, fees, books, necessary educational equipment, transportation, housing and board expenses.
