

What you should be doing NOW:

- Register to take the SAT (Remaining test dates this year): June 3, register NOW!
- Register to take the ACT (Remaining test dates this year): June 10, register NOW!



If you are finishing Algebra 2, now is the best time to take the SAT and ACT, while it is fresh in your mind.

If you are on Free & Reduced Lunch, see your counselor for a test fee waiver.


FREE Monthly Webinars for College Success

 - If you can, volunteer or intern in a field that interests you







Parents' role in the College Selection Process

 Let your child take ownership of the college selection process from beginning to end

Stand by as a sounding board and a source of encouragement and advice

• Trust your child, and trust that you have prepared your child well for this very important decision

Remember who is going to college; but have an open discussion about your wants and financial limitations as well

Create a calendar with your child and organize it with tasks
Don't hesitate to question and remind him or her of deadlines
Consider the overall cost of attendance

Complete your portion of the FAFSA and help your child compare the bottom line of all financial aid offers

 If you are considering applying for a military service academy or 4-year ROTC scholarship, start looking at your options. Application periods open 12-18 months before you begin college depending on the branch of service. It is a lengthy application process. Start NOW!








What are college admissions offices looking at?



Important dates to be aware of:

- Activate your NAVIANCE account NOW, if you haven't already
- SAT = June 3, register NOW
- ACT = June 10, register NOW
- First week of August many colleges open their application windows. Check for EA, ED, and RD deadlines.
- Fall 2017 = look for the Senior Information Night and Financial Aid for College Night
- Fall 2017 = look for college rep visits at our school on Naviance, this will be updated often throughout the fall
