## CSL Venus Manly Scholarship For St. Johns County high school seniors graduating in May 2018

The CSL established a scholarship fund in 2014 in the name of a young member, Venus Manly who transitioned early in her young life and left a big smile that would warm the hearts for all to remember her. Starting in 2018, CSL will offer an opportunity for St. Johns County graduating seniors to benefit from this fund through a scholarship. We invite graduating seniors to share their ideas in an essay about their plans on how they will make the world a better place through their education. They will present these ideas during a committee interview to win a \$1,000 scholarship.

This scholarship contest will assess the student's writing and presentation skills. To facilitate the student's growth, we will provide short workshops on writing and presentation skills at the CSL on alternating Sunday mornings at 9:15 am.

The CSL scholarship committee will score the essay and issue invitations to ten (10) semi-finalists to make an in-person interview. A combination of the highest scores of the applicant's submission of Part 1 and 2 will determine the scholarship recipients.

Part 1. An essay due by March 31, 2018.

Answer the following question in 500 words or less (min: 300 words). "What acts can you do on your own to make the world a better place?"

<u>Part 2.</u> An Interview of semi-finalists will take place before April 15, 2018. Examples of questions:

- 1. What are your post-secondary education plans after high school?
- 2. What have you done in high school to prepare for this post-secondary experience?
- 3. How do you plan to merge your experiences as a high school student from St. Johns County Florida with your future education and career?

CSL will award the scholarships before May 11, 2018.
