- Must either have or be willing to develop public speaking skills.
- Must be willing to participate in Career Academy marketing events.

### Responsibilities:

- Be the voice of your Career Academy sharing opinions, concerns and/or recommendations for improvement in a professional manner.
- Attend the Career Academy Advisory Board Meetings and visit CA teachers and students in other CTE classes within the Academy as a key communicator.
- Attend the CA Ambassador meetings to share Academy activities, learn public speaking skills, and plan for Career Academy marketing opportunities. This will also be the place to share ideas for improving your Career Academy and will enable you to be a conduit of information between your program and the District Career and Technical Education Department.
- Speak to various audiences about your Academy's programs and successes.
- Provide Career Specialists with articles to post to Career Academy blog and newsletters monthly.
