St. Johns River State College DE

- Dual Enrollment at SJRC allows you to take college courses, for FREE, while you are attending high school.
- DE Courses are weighted on a 5.0 scale, like AP courses, without the AP Exam.
- DE Courses are College courses, and my have a 'final' style exam within the course.
- DE Courses at SJRSC are usually transferrable to any Florida Public college or university, and most credits will transfer to out of state schools also. It is your job as student & parent to contact your desired institution and discuss DE transfer credits.



FAQ's

- *What is my DE Eligibility at SJR?* - You can take DE classes for 3 years in HS, grades 10-12.
- *How many hours can I take in 1 semester?* – Fall and Spring semester 10 DE credit hours, Summer you can take 2 classes total, regardless of credit hours.
- *Who do I reach out to if I have a problem?* - If you have questions/problems during the enrollment process, see your School Counselor. Once you are enrolled, all questions/problems must go through the SJRSC DE program.
- *What if I sign up and want to drop?* - If you are in the Add/Drop window you can drop with no penalty. After the add/drop window you will get a **WITHDRAW** on both your SJRSC and PVHS transcripts.



PVHS School counselors role in DE

- School counselors at PVHS are NOT college counselors or admissions officers.
- PVHS School Counselors can have discussions with students about how specific DE classes can affect their GPA, High School Graduation requirements, and High School Transcripts.
- Ultimately, Dual Enrollment courses are COLLEGE credit. PVHS school counselors will not track down students for paperwork or provide college counseling to students. College courses are the decision of the student and parent/guardian.
- If the student/parent/guardian have concerns on how DE courses will affect future college/university standings, it is the responsibility of the student/parent/guardian to reach out to preferred schools to find out their requirements or policies.



Steps to DE Application

1. Locate your SJRSC X#
2. Turn in test scores **IF** your previous test scores are older than 2 years.
3. Complete the SJR Spring 2024 Registration form with ALL required parts filled out, and submit to School Counselor

Dual Enrollment ↓

Dual Enrollment provides eligible accelerated high school students the opportunity to simultaneously earn both college credit and a high school diploma. Students may take a maximum of ten (10) Dual Enrollment credits in the fall and spring terms, and six (6) to eight (8) Dual Enrollment credits for the summer term (for a total of 2 courses maximum).  2. (possibly) Obtain your test scores. Acceptable scores include SAT, ACT, PSAT, or PERT scores. Need official score report, not a screen shot!

5. Turn in your Test Scores (if needed), **AND** Registration form to your School Counselor.

- The sooner you turn in your packet, the better chance you have of getting the classes you want!
- Your School Counselor **WILL NOT** take your registration form if you do not have 2 alternate courses/sections
- Registration form is due to your School Counselor no later than

Tuesday, Nov 28, 2023 at 4pm.
