### Pass Grade 10 FAST ELA exam

Pass End-of-Course exam Algebra 1 and/or Geometry

>USH EOC and BIO EOC are not grad req, but are 30% of grade!!

## New Personal Fin Lit requirement

Current 9<sup>th</sup> graders AND all subsequent graduating classes

- FLVS Yes, course is live
- Currently, only a standard and honors option
- *Currently,* no DE courses satisfy
- Currently, no AP courses satisfy
- This leaves us with 3 half-credit courses for senior year
- PVHS has a plan for all levels (standard AP) to meet this requirement in the senior year.

No... you do not need to sign up for this right now...

### The HOPE question -

Florida statute requires students to take one (1) credit of physical education in high school, which must include the integration of health. This course requirement can be satisfied when students successfully complete Health Opportunities through Physical Education (HOPE), a one-year course.

Due to the content, students are encouraged to take the course no earlier than the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter of their 8<sup>th</sup> grade year. The course includes topics such as Mental/Social Health, Alcohol and Drug Prevention, and Internet Safety. Students are eligible to begin the HOPE course upon their first day of the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter during their 8<sup>th</sup> grade school year.

\*\*If you sign up for HOPE before July, the MIDDLE SCHOOL approves the request

Students who earn an AICE or IB diploma are exempt from the HOPE graduation requirement. (Alternative options can be found in the High School Student Progression Plan on page 34)

### Courses come in 4 sizes

Standard – satisfies all Florida Graduation standards

Honors – faster paced and more rigorous than standard.

Advanced Placement (AP) – College level courses. Potential increase in workload, advanced reading and writing, more independent. AP Exam in May.

Dual Enrollment (DE) – Actual College courses taken through UNF or SJRSC. Can be virtual or on PVHS campus, or on the College campus. DE can be taken starting in 10<sup>th</sup> grade.

### Grades

Standard courses – SM1 (50% Q1, 50% Q2), SM2 (50% Q3, 50% Q4)

<u>Courses with a district Final exam</u> – 45% Q1, 45% Q2, 10% Exam

<u>Courses with an EOC</u> – 17.5% Q1, 17.5% Q2, 17.5%Q3, 17.5% Q4, 30%

EOC. NO SEMESTER GRADES, only final grade (Alg 1, Geom, USH, Biology)

Dual Enrollment (DE) — One final grade provided by the college

AP courses – follow Standard courses grading procedures. AP exam DOES NOT have effect on grade.

### Honors/Accelerated Criteria - SJCSD

- A student currently enrolled in an Honors/Accelerated course is eligible to continue placement in an honors course if he/she has earned a Level 4 or 5 on State Assessments and at least a C in current honors/accelerated course.
- A student currently enrolled in a standard level course is eligible for placement in an honors course if he/she has earned a Level 4 or 5 on State Assessments or earned an A in current standard course.
- A student earning a Level 3 on a State Assessment can be considered for placement in an honors course if he/she has historical data to support placement or has received administrative recommendation.

<u>Step 3 (if not resolved)</u> – *Student* makes an appointment with School Counselor to discuss question/concern.

<u>Step 4 (if not resolved)</u> – *Parent* emails School Counselor to discuss question/concern.

<u>Step 5 (if not resolved)</u> – *Parent* emails Assistant Principal to discuss question/concern.

Student **Course Verification letters** and registration procedures, will be sent home Tues Feb 20-Wed Feb 21.


Letter includes date and time and other helpful info!

Students must bring their GREEN student verification letter and elective course selection sheets completed and <u>signed</u> <u>by a parent</u> to register.

Other SJCSD 8<sup>th</sup> graders accepted through Academy Lottery – Paperwork will be sent to your current school counselor. Email will be sent with conference times to sign up. Then you will have a phone conference with a school counselor or Registrar for course requests

## Blended vs. Modified

<u>Blended schedule –</u>underclass students takes a combination of seven courses in person on campus *and* virtually.

Students can take the virtual course on campus in a monitored computer lab, or off campus.

<u>Modified Schedule</u> – <u>Seniors</u> are allowed to take less than 7 credits <u>IF</u> they are on pace for graduation at the end of their Junior year.

### Registration sheet signature requirement

#### RECOMMENDED COURSES (THIS IS NOT A SCHEDULE):

Please review these courses carefully. Teachers at PVHS take course recommendations very seriously. Discuss the workload with your child.

- If you want to keep the course listed above, make no marks and sign below.
- If you want to change a course to a lower level, mark through the course and write the new course title. EX: English 2 Honors English 2
- If you want to change a course to a <u>higher level</u>, you must submit a course petition using the link. Requests will be reviewed using the SJCSD Honors Criteria. https://forms.office.com/r/Jv4V2UGysf

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### Change a level of a course procedure –

- To keep the courses recommended, make no marks and fill out the bottom of the sheet.
- To change to a LOWER level (AP → Honors, Honors → Standard), cross out the course and write the new course next to it. Sign bottom of sheet
- To change to a HIGHER level (Standard → Honors, Honors → AP), you are required to fill out the Petition form using the link printed on the registration form.


