**Acknowledgement of Participation Requirements Form**

We have read and understand the bylaws for the Ponte Vedra Chapter of the National Honor Society. The following are the student’s obligations as a member:

- I understand that I must be registered with the NHS at the national level.
- Attendance at meetings is mandatory. Meetings are held once a month for approximately 30 minutes. The day and time of the meeting is decided by the NHS Executive Committee prior to the start of each school year (currently the first Friday of each month at PVHS). I understand that if I miss more than two monthly meetings I will be dismissed from the club.
- I understand that I am expected to earn and log at least 25 community service hours each academic year and that 5 of the hours should be split between at least 2 NHS fundraisers, service projects and activities.
- I understand that membership is based upon selection by an anonymous Faculty Council and that the proceedings of this council and all materials presented to it will be held in confidence by the school administration.
- Maintaining a high level of conduct is expected as a member of NHS. Failure to do so (level 3 offense or higher) will result in dismissal from the club.
- Member dues are collected upon acceptance into NHS. (\$30 for new members and \$15 for returning members)
- **I understand that failure to attend meetings, maintain my academic or disciplinary standing, or failure to participate in activities will be grounds for dismissal.**
