Welcome/Approval of Minutes: Mrs. Hunter welcomed members to the October meeting. After a review of the September minutes, Eric Wendell made a motion to accept the minutes and seconded by Elizabeth Paul.

School Improvement Plan: Mrs. Hunter reviewed the School Improvement Plan and Goals with members. Members reviewed By-Laws and were asked to approve. The motion to approve the SAC By-Laws was made by Michaele Harried and seconded by Eric Wendell. Mrs. Hunter also reviewed the School Year timeline.
