SAC Needs Assessment Survey discussion – Angela Hunter

- Student and faculty/staff survey are “live” and taking submissions
- Parent survey “live” status to be checked
- Surveys will be up through March 31st (required responses: parents 20%, staff 60%, students 40%)

School Recognition Funds (SRF) – Angela Hunter

- The future status of School Recognition Funds is TBD; information from the state is pending
- Past funds been used to update and replace laptops / laptop carts

Principal’s Update – Dr. Fred Oberkehr

- Only a handful of seniors are currently in jeopardy of not graduating due to state “testing requirements”
- The administration is in the process of building the master schedule for 2022-2023
 - Approx. 60 students and 12 students expressed interested in “AP Captstone” and the “Future Educators’ Academy,” respectively
- EOC, FSA, and AP testing is on the horizon; Caitlin Healy is PVHS’s new testing coordinator
- Guidance department
 - The department is down one counselor, additional moves are on the horizon
 - Patience is appreciated during this transition; parents are asked to reach out to administration with any concerns or questions
- Recent and upcoming events indicate a return to normal for PVHS students
 - *Mr. Fintastic* raised \$14,000
 - Academy Night was a success
 - Character Breakfasts are recognizing students for outstanding character
 - PVHS 101 – informational seminar for parents of upcoming freshmen
 - Athletic achievements and notable senior college acceptances were announced (i.e. cheerleading, girls’ weightlifting, soccer, Ivy League acceptance); Ms. Berrera added some military academy acceptances
 - Winter formal dance, Grad Bash, and prom all planned
