Funds Request:

- Request to send 17 teachers to Nashville, TN for Professional Development, “15 Fixes for Broken Grades,” Linda Green and Katie Baer spoke on behalf of the request, not to exceed \$25,500.
- Motion to vote on approval of the request made by Mark Procopio, seconded by Eric Wendell.
- The vote to approve the measure (PD for teachers to go to Nashville, not to exceed \$25,500) was unanimous.

SAC Bylaws for 2023-2023:

- The bylaws for 2023-2024 were put forth. Motion to approve was made by Kacey Roache. and seconded by Eric Wendell. The vote was unanimous to accept the bylaws.

Minutes:

- The April 2023 minutes were accepted. Motion to approve was made by Eric Wendell and seconded by Mark Procopio.

School Improvement Plan (4 major focus areas):

- **Focus 1** – ESSA Subgroup SWD (students w/ disabilities)
  - Use progress monitoring data, focus on the PLC process, CRISS reading strategies, the formative process
- **Focus 2** – Attendance (approximately 27% of student population missed 10% of instructional time in class)
  - Attendance team, student meetings, parking consequences, MTSS/RTI
- **Focus 3** – Instructional Coaching and Professional Development
  - Three-part series PD to help teachers w/ SWD, *Yes We Can!* Conference, “All Means All” PD, Data Chats, grading conference
- **Focus 4** – Positive Culture
  - New Shark cadre, Meet a Shark Mondays, wake-up rallies, Character Counts! Breakfasts, family nights, Lunch w/ the Arts

Principal’s Update – Dr. Fred Oberkehr

- The district financial outlook is less than optimal (i.e. budget construction difficulties)
- Dr. Oberkehr is optimistic about the 2023-2024 school year and the school’s progress
  - PVHS is ranked 291<sup>st</sup> nationally (moved up 100 spots), 26<sup>th</sup> in Florida, #1 in SJCS
  - In 2023, PVHS administered nearly 3,000 AP exams – 79% pass rate
