Senior Parking Rules and Registration Form 2021–2022

The following guidelines exist to ensure the safest and most efficient use of our parking facilities. **ONLY SENIORS** will be eligible to purchase a Parking Permit. The cost is \$100.00 (Payable via SchoolPay (attach a copy of receipt to registration form), Check to P.V.H.S., (parent phone # must be written on check), or Cash for the 2021/2022 school year. The funds collected for parking on campus go directly towards covering the costs for a Parking Attendant and miscellaneous expenses related to parking. Having a full time parking attendant is an important part of our campus and parking lot security throughout the school year. All student vehicles parking on campus must have the appropriate parking permit displayed in their vehicle for the parking lots listed below. **Parking Permits are non-transferable**.

 Honors Lot (Front 50 Spots in the Blue Lot), Blue Lot (located between gymnasium and stadium), White Lot (P/E Practice Softball Field), and Gray Lot (tennis courts/baseball-softball)

2021/2022 Seniors ONLY may purchase a parking permit by submitting a <u>completed</u> form with payment beginning <u>Monday</u>, <u>May 17th through Friday, May 28th to the Dean's Office *before* school (8:45 am-9:15 am), *during your* lunch, and *immediately after* school. A lottery of ALL seniors that have submitted their parking application and payment will take place by the administration during the last week of July. Seniors may pick up their parking permit in the Dean's Office Tuesday, <u>August 10th, 11th, 12th, & 13th between 9 AM and 12 Noon</u>. All student debt must be paid in full prior to the issuance of a parking pass. This includes outstanding fees for textbooks, athletics, food services, or any other school obligations.</u>

If you lose your permit, a TEN (\$10) DOLLAR REPLACEMENT FEE will be required.

Suspensions and Revocation of Parking Permits

Parking on school grounds is a privilege and not a right. Below are some of the offenses (not all) that may result in a student being declined the opportunity to purchase a parking permit or losing parking privileges for 30 days, 9 weeks, or having it revoked for the remainder of the school year.

NOTE: NO REFUNDS WILL BE GIVEN IF YOUR PARKING PERMIT IS SUSPENDED OR REVOKED.

- Leaving school without permission.
- Getting to school late (unexcused) three or more times during a 9-week period.
- Suspended from school.
- Unexcused absences
- Allowing another student to use parking pass.
- Parking in unauthorized areas.

- Reckless driving on campus or driving over the posted speed limit.
- Illegally obtaining, selling or duplicating a parking permit.
- Excessive violation of school rules, i.e. cutting class, class disruptions, etc.

NOTE: The Ponte Vedra High School Administration reserves the right to suspend or revoke a student's parking permit for Disciplinary reasons and/or serious violations of the St. Johns County Student Code of Conduct.

Pursuant to Florida Statute 232.256, school authorities may search lockers, personal property or other areas including vehicles when reasonable suspicion that a prohibited or illegally possessed substance or object is contained within the area.

Beginning Monday, May 17, 2021 Ponte Vedra High School will accept parking applications signed by parents (legal guardian) and student, with full payment. (\$100.00 - SchoolPay (attach a copy of receipt to registration form), Check made payable to P.V.H.S. parent phone # must be written on the check, or Cash). Parking applications and payments must be submitted to the Dean's Office no later than Friday, May 28th. Parking Permits may be picked up Tuesday, August 10th through Friday, August 13th from 9AM – 12 Noon in the Dean's Office.
