This year, on **Monday April 19, 2021**, **Ponte Vedra High School** is participating in the ASVAB Career Exploration Program, a no-cost career planning tool.

Last year, more than 786,000 students in 13,976 high schools across the nation explored the post-secondary options and found careers with ASVAB CEP. ASVAB CEP has been credited with inspiring young people to explore careers in the context of their skills and interests, resulting in greater career satisfaction, reduced student loan debt and less time wasted pursuing an ill-fitting field.

We invite you to join the movement and to help inspire young people to become #optionready. Encourage your sophomore, junior or senior to visit **Ashlee Henderson's** office in the Testing Office in the media center to sign up to participate in the ASVAB exam. Only 40 seats are available.

What to expect:

1. Students don't have to do any lengthy preparation. How much they have learned through the years will probably make the most difference in their results. Those looking for practice test items can find them here: <https://www.asvabprogram.com/student-program>
2. About two weeks after the test, results will be available in the counselor's office. We scheduled the post-test interpretation for **around May 14th**. At this session, your child will receive access to [asvabprogram.com](https://www.asvabprogram.com) where they will get score interpretation, complete an interest inventory and conduct career exploration activities. They will have access to this portal for up to two years. We encourage you to use this website with your child to discuss post-secondary planning together.
