1. Tickets are **\$155** and a limit of 200 are being sold.

 - **25** tickets and any unsold online tickets will be sold on February 12th.
2. **On February 12th,** between 8:00- 9:00 a.m. come to room 625 to complete your Grad Bash ticket purchase and select your bus. **You MUST** bring your
 - **Signed permission form**
 - **Proof of payment**
 - **Printed copy of your schedule from HAC**
3. No student will be permitted to attend without a completed permission form.
4. **Tickets are Non-Refundable and the school reserves the right to deny attendance of any student as a result of disciplinary issues.**

FAQ:

1. What does the cost of the ticket include?
 - The cost of the bus and admission to the parks.
 - Sorry no discount for season ticket holders.

2. Can I drive myself?
 - No, the event requires students and chaperones to arrive together.

3. What should I wear?
 - You should wear comfortable clothes – but school appropriate.
 - No sports teams, school names, no gym shorts, or anything revealing. Universal Studios will stop you from entering the parks! **See the dress code sheet to confirm appropriate attire.**

4. **What can I bring?**
 - Not much! A purse, fanny pack, **or** draw string bag, travel neck pillow, and a jacket are allowed.
 - No personal food or drink is allowed on the bus so **eat something before** we go! (water and a small snack will be provided for you on the bus) There is food available for purchase at the parks, so bring some extra money.
 - You may **NOT** bring personal items on the bus, including:
 - Large bags (larger than 8.5" x 11"/half a sheet of paper). You can keep your book bags in a secured storage location near the gym while we're gone. In case of car burglaries, we encourage you not to leave personal items in your cars.
 - Blankets
 - Medicine, unless already pre-approved (please be sure to see Mrs. Popp if you need to bring medication – the park has rules about labeling for all medicine brought in to the parks.)

Keep in mind that any belongings left on the bus will be unattended while we are in the parks.

5. Do I have to be at school on April 3rd?
 - **Yes**, you must sign in with Mrs. Popp in room 625 once you are on campus **and** you must be on campus for all of your scheduled classes.
 - If you haven't checked in with Mrs. Popp by 4th period **you will be removed** from the bus before we leave. This is a very strict policy!
 - ****Students who normally leave early will be REQUIRED to stay on campus until we leave. We have places for you to go and will be required to sign in.****
