Good Evening Shark Families:

It has been a great start to the 2020-2021 school year. It has been so exciting to have students back on campus. Please review carefully each of the following updates:

Masks

We understand that this is a new paradigm for our students. We have been communicating our expectations this week and observing areas needing improvement. I want to thank our families and students for understanding the importance of this effort. However, we would ask that you reinforce at home our expectations: Masks must be worn during arrival, dismissal, while transitioning from class to class, if social distancing is not possible, or if PPE is not present. Within the classroom, teachers are arbiters of requirements for masks given any PPE in place. We will continue to remind students next week.

Dress Code

Students have started the year dressing well for the most part. However, we have had instances where dress is inappropriate. We will continue to remind students next week about appropriate dress for the school setting. Students will be held accountable for poor clothing choices.

Athletics

The St. Johns County School District's (SJCSD) fall high school athletic season formally opened with practices August 24. Contests will begin Friday, September 11 with all six high schools participating in football games. In alignment with the SJCSD Reopening Plan, we will follow specific COVID-19 protocols with all athletic events. Stadium and gymnasiums will be limited to 30% spectator capacity to ensure social distancing to start the season.

Each high school will be developing ticketing strategies utilizing online sales. Masks will be required to enter the stadium/gymnasium until seated. Masks will also be required when exiting the seated area and whenever social distancing is not possible.

We look forward to the start of the season and providing a safe environment for all athletes, spectators and event staff. We appreciate your assistance in supporting our health and safety protocols here on campus.

Student Health Screening Entry Form

Please assess your child daily for the following symptoms and answer the contact questions. If you answer yes to any of the following questions, your student should NOT attend school:

- Fever of 100.4 or higher?
- Uncontrolled cough?
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing?
- Sore throat?
- Loss of sense of smell or taste?
- Muscle aches?
- Vomiting or diarrhea?
- Is your child is currently awaiting COVID-19 test result?

- Does your child live in the same household with someone positive for COVID-19?
- Has your child had close contact with someone who in the past 14 days who tested positive for COVID-19?
