- * We are trying our best to keep things as normal as possible for our students especially Seniors. We've held Band Concerts, Chicago Performances, Miss PV, Mr. Fintastic. We are still not sure about Prom. UNF is not committing to holding graduation. We are discussing options for using the football stadium.
- *Students who are sent home to quarantine have immediate access to distance learning.
- *End of year testing AP exams will take place in early May, all other testing will take place in March and April.
