- 5. **On February 15th**, between 8:00- 9:00 a.m. come to room 625 to select your bus. In order to select your bus, you must have purchased a ticket, handed in your signed permission form, signed agreement form, printed copy of your schedule from HAC, and signed up for Remind Grad Bash Group.

FAQ:

- 1. Can I drive myself?
 - No, the event requires students and chaperones to arrive together in busses.

2. Where can I park?

 You can park in your assigned parking spot or better yet have someone drop you off and pick you up at PVHS.

3. What should I wear?

- You should wear comfortable clothes but school appropriate.
- No sports teams, school names, no gym shorts, or anything revealing. Universal Studios will stop you from entering the parks! <u>See the dress code sheet to</u> <u>confirm appropriate attire.</u>

4. What can I bring?

- Not much! A purse, fanny pack, <u>or</u> draw string bag, travel neck pillow, and a jacket are allowed.
- No personal food or drink is allowed on the bus so <u>eat something before</u> we go! (water and a small snack will be provided for you on the bus) There is food available for purchase at the parks, so bring some extra money.
- You may **NOT** bring personal items on the bus, including:
 - Large bags (larger than 8.5" x 11"/half a sheet of paper). You can keep your book bags in a secured storage location near the gym while we're gone. In case of car burglaries, we encourage you not to leave personal items in your cars.
 - Blankets
 - Medicine, unless already pre-approved (please be sure to see Mrs. Popp if you need to bring medication – the park has rules about labeling for all medicine brought into the parks.)

Keep in mind that any belongings left on the bus will be unattended while we are in the parks.
