MISSION: *Youth Leadership Jacksonville (YLJ) identifies a diverse group of high school students from the First Coast who have demonstrated leadership and prepares them to become responsible, ethical leaders committed to active community involvement.*

PROGRAM OVERVIEW: YLJ is a 'once in a lifetime' experience that is challenging, eye-opening, and enriching. Students are selected from high schools in Baker, Clay, Duval and St. Johns counties to participate in activities and presentations designed to help them understand the issues facing our community, our successes at addressing issues and opportunities for involvement in all aspects of the community. The program addresses the critical skills needed to be a community leader. Like all the best things in life, it requires commitment and dedication.

TIME COMMITMENT: ATTENDANCE AT ORIENTATION, ALL RETREATS, PROGRAM DAYS, AND GRADUATION IS EXPECTED. Class 2023 Orientation will be held **Tuesday, May 3, 2022** from 5:30 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. and is **MANDATORY** for the students selected for the class and at least one of their parents or guardians. An Opening Retreat will be held on **Friday, August 26, 2022 and Saturday, August 27, 2022**. The entire Opening Retreat is **MANDATORY** for the students in the class. Program Days for Class 2023 will be on the following Thursdays: **September 15, 2022; October 13, 2022; November 3, 2022; December 1, 2022; January 26, 2023 and February 23, 2023**. The Closing Retreat/Graduation will be on **Saturday, March 25, 2023**.

Parents will need to provide transportation to the designated drop-off point for all retreats and program days and pick up at this same location at the end of the program day. Drop-off is generally between 7:15 am and 7:45 am. Program Days ends at 3:30 p.m. Pick-Up is at 3:30 p.m.

ELIGIBILITY

- ❑ Attend a participating high school in Duval, Clay, Baker, or St. Johns counties.
- ❑ **Apply as a freshman for the program (if selected, participate in the sophomore year).**
- ❑ Demonstrate proven leadership in school and/or community activities.
- ❑ Have an interest in addressing the issues confronting your community.
- ❑ Commit to 100% attendance at the Orientation, Opening Retreat, Six Program Days and Closing Retreat. Program Days are from 7:45 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.
- ❑ Be academically sound. An average of "B" or better is recommended.

APPLICANT CHECKLIST

- ❏ Complete the application form completely. Make sure to save your document. Either e-mail your completed application to your school's Youth Leadership Jacksonville Faculty Advisor or print and give to your school's Youth Leadership Jacksonville Faculty Advisor.
- ❏ Your Faculty Advisor will provide a Reference Form to students your school selects as applicants to YLJ. Give reference forms to an adult you know well, other than a parent or relative. The reference must be included with your application to Youth Leadership Jacksonville to be considered.
- ❏ Return your completed application packet to your school's Youth Leadership Jacksonville Faculty Advisor by the deadline your school has established. Your school will select applications to forward to the Leadership Jacksonville Office for participation in the Selection Process.

SELECTION PROCESS

- ❏ All applicants will be interviewed by three to five members of the Selection Team via Zoom in February or March 2022.
- ❏ Be advised that members of the same family (including siblings and cousins) will not be selected for participation in the same program year.
- ❏ Letters will be sent to all applicants to notify them of their interview date and time.
- ❏ The Selection Team and the Leadership Jacksonville Board of Directors will select 52 students to participate in Class 2023 during the 2022-2023 School Year. All Applicants will receive letters notifying them of the Selection Team's decision by April 15, 2022.

PROGRAM FEE AND SCHOLARSHIPS FOR SELECTED STUDENTS

Cost per selected participant is \$250. Scholarships will be provided for those with financial need. This fee will be due at the Orientation for the selected students. **There are no fees due with the application.**
