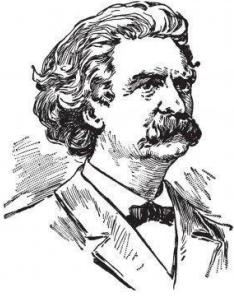


PVHS AP Literature Summer 2023 Reading

1. *The Adventures of Huckleberry Finn* (unabridged) by, Mark Twain

Directions: Read and annotate *The Adventures of Huckleberry Finn*. While reading this novel, you should annotate very carefully, marking the novel, and recording page numbers of specific scenes or quotes that you find meaningful. Also, students should begin to identify themes, literary elements, and author's purpose to build the foundation for essay writing for AP Literature where students seek to answer the questions: What? (Title, author, theme) How? (Literary elements) Why? (What is the author's purpose?) These questions are the cornerstones of Literary Analysis. After several weeks of instruction, students will be asked to write their first Literary Analysis Free-Response essay utilizing the novel *The Adventures of Huckleberry Finn*.
