Senior Parking Spots

Seniors for the 2023-2024 School Year will be able to turn in a completed Senior Parking Rules and Regulations form with payment beginning **Monday, May 1st** through **Friday, May 19th** in the Dean's office during the following times:

- Before School 8:45 AM until 9:15 AM
- During their lunch time
- Immediately after school

The cost is \$120, payable on **SchoolPay, Check** (payable to PVHS and including phone number on the check), or **Cash**. Forms will be available online and in the Dean's Office. ALL Seniors that turned in an application and payment are then in a lottery to determine their parking spot in the following sequence:

1. The Top 50 Weighted GPA are in the front of the Blue Lot (Between the gym & football field).
2. The next 160 spots in Blue Lot are determined.
3. All Seniors that are not assigned the Blue Lot are given a spot in the White Lot (the next closest lot to the school).

A senior assigned to a White Lot space may opt to switch to our Gray Lot. The Gray Lot is a longer walk but it is paved, and the White Lot is gravel.

Parking Permits will be available for pickup starting **Thursday August 3rd** through **August 9th** from **9 AM – Noon**.

Juniors for the 2023-2024 School Year will be eligible for the remaining parking spots available after all seniors get an opportunity to purchase and get their spots assigned. We will not accept Junior Parking Applications until the start of the new school year in August.

We just want to send a couple reminders pertaining to students checking out of school early:

The registration process is to be completed online only and all pages of the EL2 physical MUST be uploaded. Paper physicals will not be accepted.

New this year - you will be required to upload all of the safety certificates to Athletic Clearance:

- FHSAA Sudden Cardiac Arrest Video Certificate
- NFHS Concussion Certificate
- NFHS Heat Illness Certificate
- NFHS Sudden Cardiac Arrest Certificate

Please visit the Ponte Vedra Athletic Website for step-by-step registration instructions and to download a copy of a blank EL2 physical form to take to your medical provider.

The Registration Process MUST be completed and student-athlete must be cleared prior to participating in conditioning or tryouts. Please keep in mind that it could take up to 5 days for EL2 physical clearance in order to participate.

ATHLETIC REGISTRATION FEES

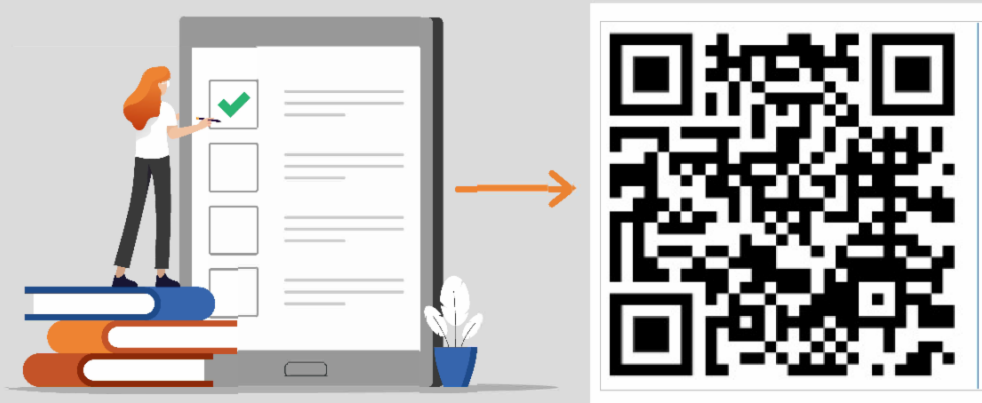
