PROGRAM OVERVIEW:

YLJ is an experience that is challenging, eye-opening, and enriching. Students are selected from high schools in Baker, Clay, Duval, and St. Johns counties to participate in activities and presentations designed to help them understand the issues facing our community, our successes at addressing issues, and opportunities for involvement in all aspects of the community. The program addresses the critical skills needed to be a community leader.

TIME COMMITMENT:

ATTENDANCE AT ORIENTATION, BOTH RETREATS, PROGRAM DAYS, AND GRADUATION IS EXPECTED.

- YLJ 2025 Orientation will be held **Monday, April 29, 2024** from 5:30 7:30 pm and is **MANDATORY** for selected students and at least one of their parents or guardians.
- An Opening Retreat will be held on **Friday, August 23, 2024 and Saturday, August 24, 2024** and attendance both days is **MANDATORY.**
- Program Days for YLJ 2025 will be on the following Thursdays:
 September 12, 2024; October 10, 2024; November 7, 2024; December 5, 2024; January 16, 2025; and February 13, 2025.
- The Closing Retreat/Graduation will be on Saturday, March 8, 2025.
 Parents will need to provide transportation to the designated drop-off point for all retreats and program days and pick up at the end of the program day. Drop-off is generally between 7:30 am and 7:45 am. Program Days end at 3:30 pm and pick-up is also at 3:30 pm. The location of each Program Day may vary, however, drop-off and pick-up will be at the same location.

ELIGIBILITY:

- Attend a participating high school in Baker, Clay, Duval or St. Johns counties.
- Demonstrate proven leadership in school and/or community activities.
- Have an interest in addressing the issues confronting our community.
- Commit to 100% attendance at the Orientation, Opening Retreat, Six Program Days and Closing Retreat. Program Days are from 7:45 am 3:30 pm.
- Academically committed with a "B" average or higher.

APPLICANT CHECKLIST:

- ✓ Complete the application form, and make sure to save your document. Either e-mail your completed application to your school's Youth Leadership Jacksonville School Liaison or print and deliver it to your school's Youth Leadership Jacksonville School Liaison.
- Return your completed application packet to your school's Youth Leadership Jacksonville School Liaison by the deadline your school has established. Your school will select applications to forward to the Leadership Jacksonville Office for participation in the Selection Process.

HELPFUL HINTS:

- Be thorough in your answers.
- Please spell out names of organizations (ex. National Honor Society instead of NHS).
- You (the student) must fill out the application not a parent, teacher, sibling or friend.
- All answers to application questions should be on the forms provided online additional pages will not be accepted.
- Make sure to add your e-mail address on the application. Check your email regularly for updates and next steps.

SELECTION PROCESS:

- All applicants will be interviewed by three to five members of the Selection Team via Zoom in February or March 2024.
- Emails will be sent to all applicants to notify them of their interview date and time.
- Members of the same family (including siblings and cousins) will not be selected for participation in the same program year.
- The Selection Team and the Leadership Jacksonville Board of Directors will select more than 50 students to participate in YLJ 2025 during the 2024-2025 school year. All Applicants will receive letters notifying them of the Selection Team's decision by April 25, 2024.

PROGRAM FEE AND SCHOLARSHIPS FOR SELECTED STUDENTS:

Cost per selected participant is \$250. This fee will be due at the Orientation for the selected students. Scholarships will be provided for those with financial need.

There are no fees due with the application.
