

2025 State-Funded ACT College Reportable for Juniors – February 25th, 2025

The ACT will be administered free of charge to all juniors on Tuesday, February 25th. Testing will begin promptly at 9:20am. This is free to all juniors enrolled at Ponte Vedra High School and **no registration is needed.**

PRE-TEST INSTRUCTIONS FOR STUDENTS:

11th grade students will be receiving Non-Test Information to complete (this week) for receiving and sending their scores that must be **done prior to the test date.** They will receive this information from their English teacher. If they are not enrolled in English at PVHS, another teacher will provide the information packet.

TESTING LOCATIONS:

Students will test in assigned testing rooms organized by last name. Signs will be posted around campus and testing locations will be posted in the JUNIORS Schoology Group.

DISMISSAL ON February 25TH:

This state-funded ACT College Reportable test is only available for juniors on February 25th. All 9th, 10th, and 12th graders will be allowed an at-home learning day. To ensure an optimal testing environment, we will allow flexibility to students on this day. High school students who are not participating in the ACT College Reportable test may complete assigned work from home or at school on this day. This includes juniors who choose not to participate in the school day ACT. Teachers will be in communication of expectations online that day. Students that report to school that day will be held in the auditorium for a study hall and will be provided lunch once all testing has concluded
