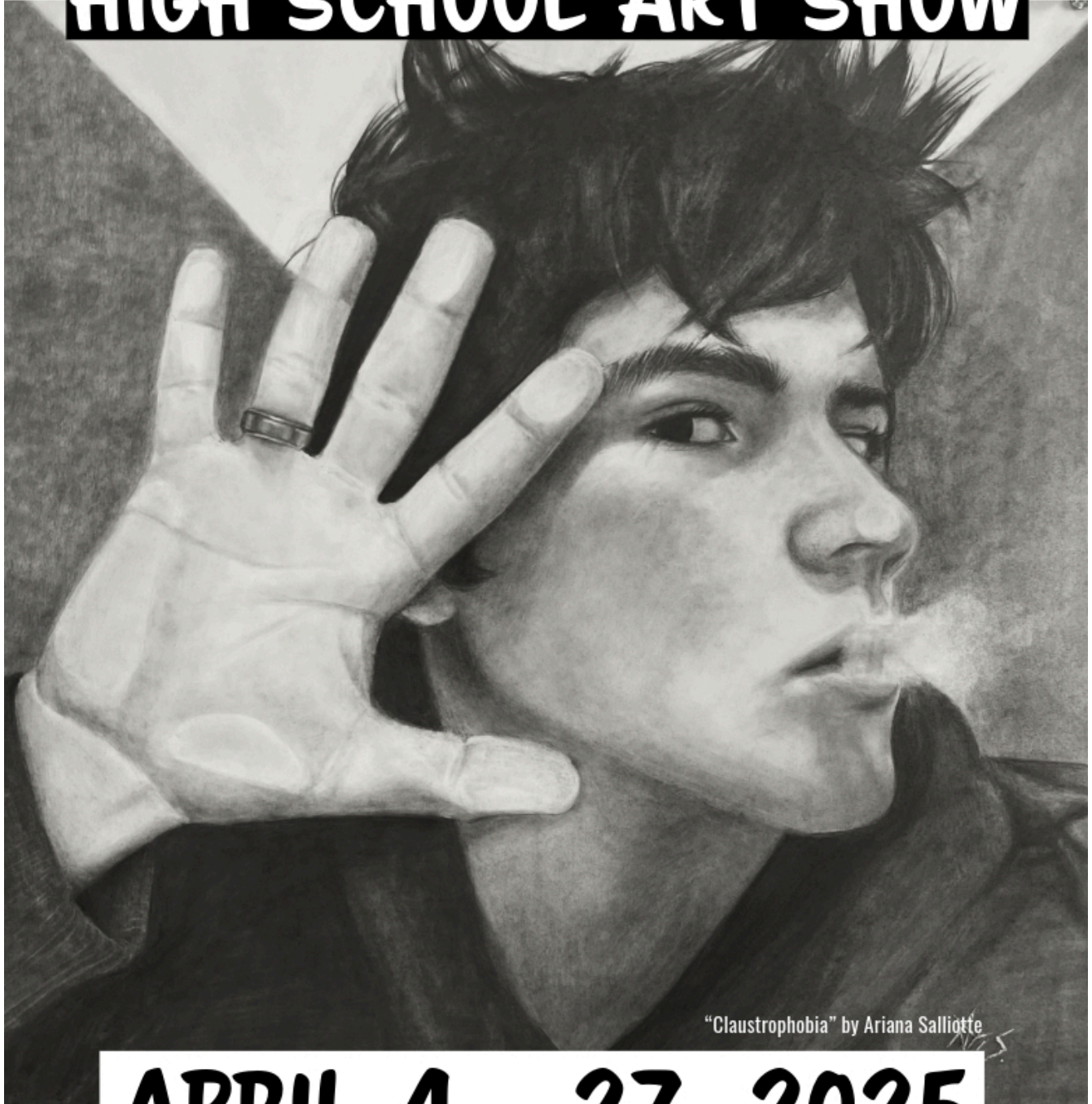

About the Judges
